### Hospital Admissions – the Data Protection Act

The Derby hospitals' interpretation of the Data Protection Legislation means that they will no longer issue lists of Catholic patients to the Hospital Chaplaincy staff.

The only way to ensure that a Catholic patient receives a visit and is offered the sacraments, is to notify your parish priest

stating:-           date of admission  
                          date for planned surgery if appropriate  
                          Ward number

Registering as a Catholic on admission to hospital will no longer ensure that a patient is visited by some-one from the chaplaincy.
