Service to commemorate the Centenary of WW1: This will take place on Sunday 27 July at 3.00pm at the Church of All Saints, Ockbrook. All are welcome.

Rosary Rally:

The Annual Rosary Rally will take place at Grace Dieu Manor, Leicestershire on Sunday 24th August, beginning with Mass at 3pm. The principal celebrant will be Fr Anselm Stark OCSO from Mount St Bernard Abbey. After Mass there will be a break for picnics and refreshment resuming at 5pm with solemn crowning of the statue of Our Lady followed by the rosary, benediction and the blessing of the sick. There will be a free vote, because it not Government legislation. If passed, this Bill would place vulnerable people at serious risk. Especially if you have direct experience of caring for a dying person, either as a family member or as a health or social care professional, please write before 18th July to a Peer, to tell them your views.
