Gift Aid: The entitlement to Gift Aid relies on the donor being a taxpayer and having sufficient income subject to tax to cover all of their Gift Aid donations. Unfortunately, the Finance Office has no way of knowing that this is the case, and relies on the donor themselves telling us that they no longer pay tax and that their Gift Aid declaration needs to be cancelled. Given that fewer people now pay tax as a result of the personal allowances for income tax being raised, I would be grateful if parishioners who are **not** eligible to Gift Aid because they are no longer taxpayers to advise the Finance Office (email: giftaid@nrcdt.org.uk) of this as soon as possible, and also from what tax year this applies.

Flame 2 – 7 March 2015: This national gathering of young Catholics at Wembley Arena on Saturday 7 March is open to all young people (year ten upwards), teachers, catechists and youth leaders. This promises to be a day to remember with over 12,000 young people expected from across England & Wales. Most of our secondary schools will be bringing buses and there will be coaches from The Briars for any individuals or small parish groups.
